TO THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

San Gabriel Valley Water Company ("San Gabriel") hereby requests ministerial review of the following changes in tariff sheets applicable to its Los Angeles County and Fontana Water Company divisions:

The Commission approved Advice Letter 409-A, effective April 1, 2012, authorizing San Gabriel to recover from customers the difference between authorized and interim rate revenues tracked in its Interim Rate Memorandum Account (IRMA). This advice letter seeks to make minor corrections on two of the adopted tariff sheets. **San Gabriel designates this supplemental advice as Tier 1**, and is requesting the same April 1, 2012 effective date as Advice Letter 409-A.

Discussion

Two tariff sheets authorized by Advice Letter 409-A contain minor errors:

1. For the Fontana Water Company division, Schedule FO-1C, General Metered Service – Conservation Rates (Tariff Sheet 2097-W), inadvertently excluded a previously authorized \$0.0298/Ccf surcharge which had appeared on the superseded Tariff Sheet No. 2083-W and which also appears on Schedule

April 11, 2012

FO-1 (Tariff Sheet 2096-W) approved in Advice Letter 409-A. This advice letter re-inserts that Special Condition No. 2 back into Schedule FO 1-C.

2. For the Los Angeles County Division, Tariff Sheet 2093-W approved in Advice Letter 409-A added a Special Condition No. 5 to Schedule No. LA-1C, General Metered Service – Conservation Rates. However, there are only three other special conditions in that tariff. This advice letter re-numbers Special Condition No. 5 as Special Condition No. 4.

No additional workpapers or earnings tests are associated with this advice letter. Distribution of this Advice Letter is being made to the attached service lists in accordance with Water Industry Rule 4.1 of General Order 96-B, and San Gabriel will post this Advice Letter on its website in accordance with Water Industry Rule 3.3. No further public notice is required because all public notices in connection with Application No. 10-07-019 have already been made in accordance with applicable law and Commission rules.

San Gabriel requests that the attached proposed tariffs be made effective for service rendered on and after April 1, 2012.
